## **Things to know about SWAC's Summer Adventure Camp**

- **Camp is based out of Sandpoint West Athletic Club. Check in and out through the outside gate in the outdoor courtyard.**
- **Camp starts promptly at 10:00am and ends at 5:00pm**  
**Please drop off and pick up your child up promptly. A camp counselor must make contact with the parent/ guardian before the camper may be released. If a camper is to walk/bike home from camp, a signed written notice needs to be delivered to Emily or Lexie before camp begins.**
- **Campers travel by foot or school buses to activities with qualified, caring counselors**  
~ **Good walking shoes are a MUST, EVERYDAY**
- **Swimming is part of almost everyday**  
~ **Please pack a swimsuit, towel, sunscreen & water bottle EVERYDAY**
- **Electronic devices are NOT to be used during camp.**
- **Cost of camp covers all costs associated with the week's camp.**
- **Please prepare a healthy lunch with some extra snacks for your child to have throughout the day.**
- **In case of emergencies, call Sandpoint West at 263-6633. The front desk will have the numbers of the counselors working that day along with their daily itinerary. In case of an emergency at camp and/or a camper refuses to adhere to camp regulations or rules of conduct, the parent/ guardian will be contacted and will be responsible to pickup camper immediately.**
- **We reserve the right to modify the scheduled activities due to weather and other factors beyond our control.**

**Dear Parents/ Guardians,**

**Thank you for signing up your child to participate in Summer Adventure Camp (SAC). This summer promises to be one full of exciting themes, games, activities and most importantly fun and adventure for each day and every camper. To make this experience enjoyable for not only your camper but yourself as well, we would like to inform you of what the \$70 fee includes each week, what each camper needs to bring daily, a flexible schedule of the daily routine, and certain guidelines parents should be aware of.**

**Please pack a nutritious lunch/snacks and beverage for your camper. The tuition fee covers all costs for activities throughout the week. If your child wants to purchase snacks before or after camp at SWAC or other destination, they are welcome to bring spending money from home. Parents may want to limit spending money as Summer Adventure Camp does not take responsibility for lost or stolen money/ property.**

**This year we are partnering with some talented Art Instructors, Bethany Williamson and Mary Johnson. Kids will be introduced a variety of different artists each week a brief introduction about the artist and their lives will be shared.**

**Swimming is part of most days' activities, campers need to bring an appropriate swimsuit and towel in their backpack. Each camper should come prepared with plenty of sunscreen and water bottle to keep hydrated. SAC is implementing a 15-30 min. reading/quiet activity time each day after lunch. Each camper should plan accordingly and bring reading material or some other quiet activity. Electronic devices are NOT allowed to be brought to camp and will be confiscated if needed.**

**Camp starts at 10:00 and ends at 5:00 pm daily. We ask that you drop off and pick up your child as close to those times as possible. In case of late arrival/or early pickup, arrangements need to be made with one of the camp directors, in advance. Campers will NOT under any circumstances be left at a location to be picked up later by parent/guardian. A camp counselor must make visual contact with the parent/ guardian before the camper will be released. If a camper is to walk/bike home from camp, a signed written notice needs to be delivered to a senior counselor before camp begins.**

**In case of emergencies, SAC can be reached by calling Sandpoint West at 263-6633. The front desk will have a schedule of the day's activities and messages can be left with them. In case of an emergency at camp and/or a camper refuses to adhere to camp regulations or rules of conduct, the parent/ guardian will be contacted and be responsible to pickup child immediately.**

**Once again, thank you for registering your child to participate in Summer Adventure Camp. The counseling staff is looking forward to making this a summer your camper will look back on with fond memories for years to come! # SWAC Summer Adventure Camp

## **RULES AND GUIDELINES**

The goal is to provide a positive and safe environment that will allow your child to have a fun time while at SWAC Summer Adventure Camp.

### Expectations for Day Camp

HAVE FUN and meet new friends!

Be polite and respect others. Abusive language and teasing will not be tolerated.

Listen to staff and follow directions and rules.

Stay with your assigned group or "buddy" at all times within the approved area- so not leave without permission.

Be kind to each other ( fighting, bad language, aggressive & non-cooperative behavior is not allowed).

The SWAC Summer Adventure Camp program revolves around choices. Staff will do there best to work with campers in helping them make the best choices possible. Staff will follow the steps outlined below in reinforcing positive behavior and changing negative behaviors.

### **Positive Reinforcement**

Staff will give as many positive comments and recognition as possible to campers who are doing a good job in meeting expectations.

### **Friendly Reminder**

Staff will give a quiet reminder, explain any inappropriate behavior, and let the camper know what is expected and the consequences associated if the negative behavior continues.

### **Time Out**

Staff will ask the child to sit out from an activity for a short time.

### **Parent Phone Call**

If problems continue, the Camp Director will contact the child's parents. The parent may be asked to come and pick up their child for the remainder of that day.

If behavior problems continue or become worse the child may be removed from the camp.

I understand that inappropriate behavior will be recorded on a Behavior Log and tracked throughout the week. I will be made aware of the recorded behavior and will discuss it with the program staff.

I understand that the SWAC Summer Adventure Camp Program is here to give me the opportunity to participate in new activities. I realize I must conduct myself in an acceptable manner at all times in order for myself and others to benefit from this program.

It is our goal to help each child develop self-control, as well as respect for the others. If you have any questions or concerns regarding Rules and Guidelines of camp, please contact the camp director. Misbehavior on field trips may result in your child not attending the next field trip. Should any child behave in a manner that threatens the safety of the staff, fellow campers or themselves, they may be immediately dismissed from the program.
